



Zen Underwater Ports for Pen Housings

Congratulations on the purchase of your new Zen Underwater port! All Zen Underwater Ports are constructed from the finest quality optical glass that is multicoated to eliminate flare and reflections. All aluminum parts are hard anodized, making them rugged and impervious to corrosion.

Care & Feeding

We recommend removing the port o-rings from the port for travel. Don't forget to replace the port o-rings before diving!

After diving, the entire system should be soaked in fresh water to dissolve any salt crystals that may have accumulated. After rinsing, blot any water droplets off of the port with a soft terry towel or chamois, and allow to air dry. Water droplets left on the lens can etch the coating in direct sunlight.

When cleaning the glass, use only a microfiber cloth. Do not use any cleaning solutions!

It is recommended that the port sealing o-rings be replaced annually.

Installation

The PT-EPxx Housing Port attachment is very similar to the bayonet mounts used in many housing systems.

To remove the Olympus PT-EPxx Flat Port:

1. Open the housing, and remove the Phillips head screw that holds the port-locking clip in place.



2. Grasp the port firmly and rotate 90 degrees clockwise (PT-EP01, PT-EP03) or counter clockwise (PT-EP05L).

3. Pull the port straight out of the housing.

To install the Zen Underwater Port:

1. Lubricate the port's double o-ring seal, and make sure that the o-rings, their grooves, and the sealing surface of the housing are completely clean.

2. Align the Zen Underwater logo on the port at 3 o'clock (PT-EP01, PT-EP03) or 9 o'clock (PT-EP05L), and push straight in to the housing.



3. Rotate the port anti-clockwise (PT-EP01, PT-EP03) or clockwise (PT-EP05L) 90 degrees until the Zen Underwater logo is oriented at 12 o'clock.

4. Replace the PT-EPxx port lock & screw if desired.
